Our vision statement

Aims

To provide within our Children's Centres an environment where everyone is respected regardless of race, religion, age, gender, ethnicity and /or disability, and to offer advice and guidance in a supportive and nurturing manner.

Objectives

To encourage adults and children to respect one another, to listen to each other and share experiences and to be kind and considerate towards each other.

Here at a YMCA Children's Centre, we accept that there are many different views on child rearing practice, but verbal or physical abuse will not be tolerated, this includes smacking and shouting at any children. Any adult who behaves in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave the premises and the police will be called.

It is the duty of a responsible adult to supervise their child/ren and to use positive behaviour management when disciplining their child/ren, when in the Children's Centre.

Any adult who behaves in an inappropriate manner will be required not to return for a period of 2 weeks. If after this time, an adult continues to behave inappropriately and breaches the Watford & District YMCA's Code of Conduct, they will be **banned** from attending any of the YMCA's Children's Centres.

Watford and District YMCA will not tolerate any kind of verbal or physical aggression from adults or children towards each other and Children's Centre Staff.
