What is A Toy Library?

A toy library works in the same way as a book library.

It is a way of borrowing carefully selected, safe and educational toys for your child to take home to play with. You can borrow from a huge variety of toys for babies & children from 0 - 5 years.

Toy libraries offer:

- loan of a wide range of toys
- play sessions for children and parents
- information and advice about play and child development

Helping children:

- by giving access to a rich variety of high quality toys
- by enabling all children to develop vital skills
- by helping children learn to share
- by providing safe spaces to play, learn and have fun
- by finding toys to suit the abilities of children with additional needs

Supporting parents and carers:

- To discover the appropriate toys and play activities for their children
- in understanding the role of play in child development in developing parenting skills
- in providing a meeting place to meet other families & make friends

What does the Toy Library Cost?

To use the library you must join and become a member. Membership costs just £3.50 per year and requires 2 forms of ID (one must be a photo)
 Toy loan costs between 50p and £2 per fortnight. We have some special very large toys ideal for birthday parties and these are approx £5 per weekend.
