



## Code of Conduct

The Children's Centre Code of Conduct states that –

- Parents and carers will act responsibly at all times
- Any suspicions of a child at risk must to be reported immediately to the Centre Manager
- Using inappropriate language in front of, about, or to a child is to be avoided at all times
- Any form of abuse, bullying, discrimination, violence or any other offensive or inappropriate behaviour to be reported to the Centre Manager
- The Centre will be maintained as a safe environment for all
